COMPETITION RULES AND NOTES FOR GUIDANCE 2023

- 1 The Judges' decision is final.
- 2 In the Heats, competitors may perform one or two pieces which in total should not exceed the time limit, but only one piece in the Finals.
- 3 Time limits as given in the table below are the maximum time allowed and if any competitor goes beyond the time limit prescribed for their class then penalty marks may be deducted.
- 4 All competitors will receive a written report from the organisers after the heats.
- 5 The judges will normally select 2 people from each class to take part in the Finals.
- 6 At the Finals all competitors must be present at the venue 10 minutes before their class is due to start.
- 7 Finalists will perform the same piece as at the Heats at the Finals.
- 8 Recorded backing tracks may be used at the heats and for the finals.
- 9 Trophies and prize money to be awarded are as follows:
 - The Alcan Trophy plus £100 prize money for the Young Musician of the Year 2023
 - The Humphries Family Trophy for the Junior Musician of the Year 2023
 - The Ensemble Trophies for the winning ensemble in Junior and Intermediate/Seniors.
 - The Choir Trophies for the winning choir in Junior and Intermediate/Seniors.
 - The One Man Band Trophy for the most improved student taking part during the last three years
 - The Tudor Hall Trophy for the most improved Junior Competitor taking part since the previous year
 - The Bluecoat Trophy for the highest placed student from the Old Borough of Banbury
- 10 If a competitor has any connection with an adjudicator this must be made known to the Competition Organiser before they begin performing.
- 11 This Competition is a public event at which photographs may be taken for media purposes.

After their performance each ensemble will receive a few minutes coaching from the adjudicators. Time limit 8 minutes.
