I am pleased to report that all the floors have been concreted and the doors and windows have been fitted. Rendering has now started and we are well on the way to completing the build. I have also had the price for building a ramp at the front of the house which will give Momoh easier access and this will also be completed in the near future.

The concrete lining of the well is completed and we will soon progress the work further, as funds permit. This will make a huge difference to the school and the entire community.



Fundraising update

Despite the Covid situation in the UK I have had my most successful year of fundraising to date and I would like to take this opportunity of thanking EVERYONE who has supported me this Rotary year, and over the last fourteen and a half years since I started working directly with communities. The Rotary year ends on June 30th and at the moment my total for the year stands at **£35,600** & this weekend saw the total raised for my projects, since January 2007, break the **£300,000** mark.

None of this would have been possible without the fantastic support I have received from literally hundreds of individuals and organisations over the years, and to each and every one of you, please accept my sincere thanks for helping me to “**Make A Real Difference**” in Sierra Leone.

During this time, together, **WE** have:

- built and equipped 34 classrooms – 9 with mains electricity & 21 with water harvesting systems
- built 8 toilet blocks (6 with water harvesting & handwash stations)
- sunk 3 wells and refurbished another 3
- installed a gravity fed water system to a church/school community which provides running water and flushing toilets to the benefit of over 1,500 people
- installed running water, toilets and a shower to a hostel for 8 orphaned lads
- undertaken MANY refurbishment projects
- provided thousands of pounds of assorted humanitarian aid to several communities

Looking forward

There are still ongoing projects to complete and I know that more projects will come along in the future, but while I can, and with continued support, I will endeavour to support these communities. I hope to extend my Micro Credit scheme to assist more individuals to become self sufficient and will continue to guarantee that **EVERY** £ raised goes directly to the projects.
