The Rotary year July 2022 – June 2023

The Rotary year ended on June 30th and once again it has been a busy year for AlansAfrica. During the year we have funded the following projects:

- The building & equipping of 2 additional classrooms at Kankalay School, Port Loko
- The installation of solar panel electricity system at Banbury International School
- Completion of the building and equipping of 2 classrooms at Liverpool School and the installation of a water harvesting system on the classroom block.
- The building and equipping of 2 additional classrooms at Banbury International School
- Supporting Fayia's five children with payment of school fees
- Shipped several small consignments of sports kit and other items to various communities.
- Providing ongoing support for Momoh & his carer and shipped a wheelchair for him
- Providing support for Emma (an orphaned burns victim), her 2 sisters & grandma.
- Paid medical maternity costs for Howa and support for her and baby, Alan Junior.
- Paid examination fees for 120 children who were unable to pay for their exams
- Funded annual university fees for Sahr, a teacher at Banbury International School
- Expanded my Sierra LeOANS micro credit scheme to another 2 ladies
- Supported 300+ girls with the provision of sanitary products
- Funded college fees and accommodation costs for Mariama, an orphaned teenager
- Supported the running costs for a group of orphans at the Mahera Wharf FC hostel
- Provided several individuals with financial support for medical bills.
- Purchased a plot of land in Konno Town to create a new secondary school as children are currently walking up to 5 miles each way to attend classes.

During this Rotary year £38,600+ has been raised for projects in Sierra Leone

The success of my projects is due to a fantastic network of supporters across the UK & beyond. I would like to express my sincere thanks to **everybody** that has contributed either financially, or with donations of items or in the provision of support of any kind. When I first visited Sierra Leone in 2005, for a "one off life experience" I never imagined that, eighteen years later, I would have been to the country 13 times and achieved so much.

Phase 1, to build 2 classrooms, an office & staffroom is well underway – the roof has been fitted, the floors concreted and the windows and doors will be completed by the weekend. The furniture for the block is funded and they are starting to make the desk and bench sets. Phase 2, a toilet block, has begun - they have dug the pit and are now starting to build. Phase 3 will see additional classrooms being built as funds permit – foundations have started.
