# COMPETITION RULES AND NOTES FOR GUIDANCE 2024

- The Judges' decision is final. 1
- 2 All competitors must bring with them 2 extra copies of the music that will be performing for use by the Judges.
- 3 In the Heats, competitors may perform one or two pieces which in total should not exceed the time limit, but only one piece in the Finals.
- Time limits as given in the table below are the maximum time allowed and if any competitor goes beyond the 4 time limit prescribed for their class then penalty marks may be deducted.
- 5 All competitors will receive a written report from the organisers after the heats.
- The judges will normally select 2 people from each class to take part in the Finals. 6
- 7 At the Finals all competitors must be present at the venue 10 minutes before their class is due to start.
- 8 Finalists will perform the same piece as at the Heats at the Finals.
- Recorded backing tracks may be used at the heats and for the finals.
- Trophies and prize money to be awarded are as follows:
  - The Alcan Trophy plus £100 prize money for the Young Musician of the Year 2024
  - The Humphries Family Trophy for the Junior Musician of the Year 2024
  - The Ensemble Trophies for the winning ensemble in Junior and Intermediate/Seniors.
  - The One Man Band Trophy for the most improved student taking part during the last three years
  - The Tudor Hall Trophy for the most improved Junior Competitor taking part since the previous year
  - The Bluecoat Trophy for the highest placed student from the Old Borough of Banbury
- 11 If a competitor has any connection with an adjudicator this must be made known to the Competition Organiser before they begin performing.
- 12 This Competition is a public event at which photographs may be taken for media purposes.

#### CLASSES FOR ENSEMBLE TROPHIES

### **Instrumental or Mixed Ensembles of 3-9 players.**

One Junior Ensemble Class and one Intermediate/Senior Class for Mixed Ensembles. All performers in the Junior Class must be aged 8-11. Adjudication will focus primarily on musicianship (sense of style, interpretation, communication with the audience) and the quality of the ensemble. After their performance each ensemble will receive a few minutes coaching from the adjudicators. Time limit 8 minutes.
